Bal Harbour officers arrived and located a male who appeared to be inebriated and asleep. As a precaution, the Bal Harbour officers requested Miami Dade Fire Rescue to respond. The suspicious male was awoken and evaluated by Miami Dade Fire Rescue. The male was disoriented and had a prominent odor of alcohol emanating from his person. A Bal Harbour officer transported the male to Aventura Hospital where he was admitted under the Marchman's Act. The male's mother was contacted and informed of the status of her son.</p>
