An unknown subject removed a ladies purse from a chair in the main dining room area inside of Carpaccio's. The suspect then entered the men's room located on the second floor of the shops, removed a hotel key and discarded the purse along with all of its other contents. The purse along with the remaining contents were returned to the victim with a value of approximately \$850.00. The incident was captured on CCTV surveillance where the subject can be seen on a cell phone as he walked around the establishment. Bal Harbour police officers conducted a thorough area canvass and all restaurants in the shops were notified. Sunny Isles, Surfside and Bay Harbor Islands police departments were also notified. The surveillance video and a photo of the offender was obtained and turned over to the Bal Harbour criminal investigations unit.
